# ARCHIVING place

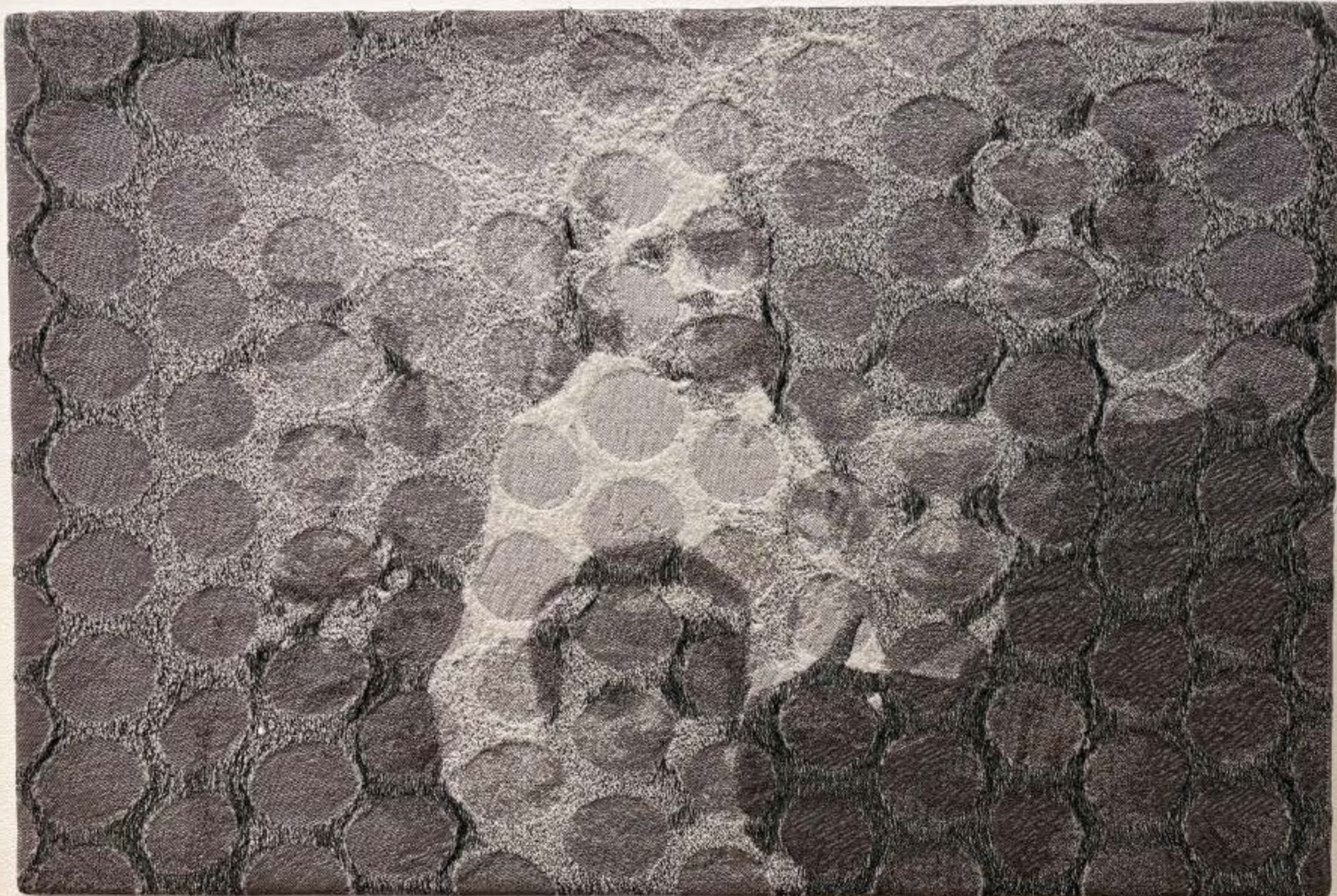
Archiving Place examines the sense of place through the perspective of textile artists from the Southeast region. Whether place is interpreted through physical geography, cultural practices, emotional connections, symbolic significance, and/or virtual space, the artwork is documentation of each artists' personal experience.

Textile arts capture the essence of place through texture, color, patterns, and material choice. The very nature of textile processes – the building up through stitching, quilting, weaving, printing, beading, etc – act as a vehicle for expressing this connection. The shared human experience reflected in textiles creates a bridge between the artist's personal interpretation and the viewer's broader understanding, fostering a sense of shared memories and significance.

The featured artists are members of the Southeast Fibers Educators Association (SEFEA), a collective of textile artists and educators, both active and emeritus, teaching in higher education in the Southeast Region of the United States.

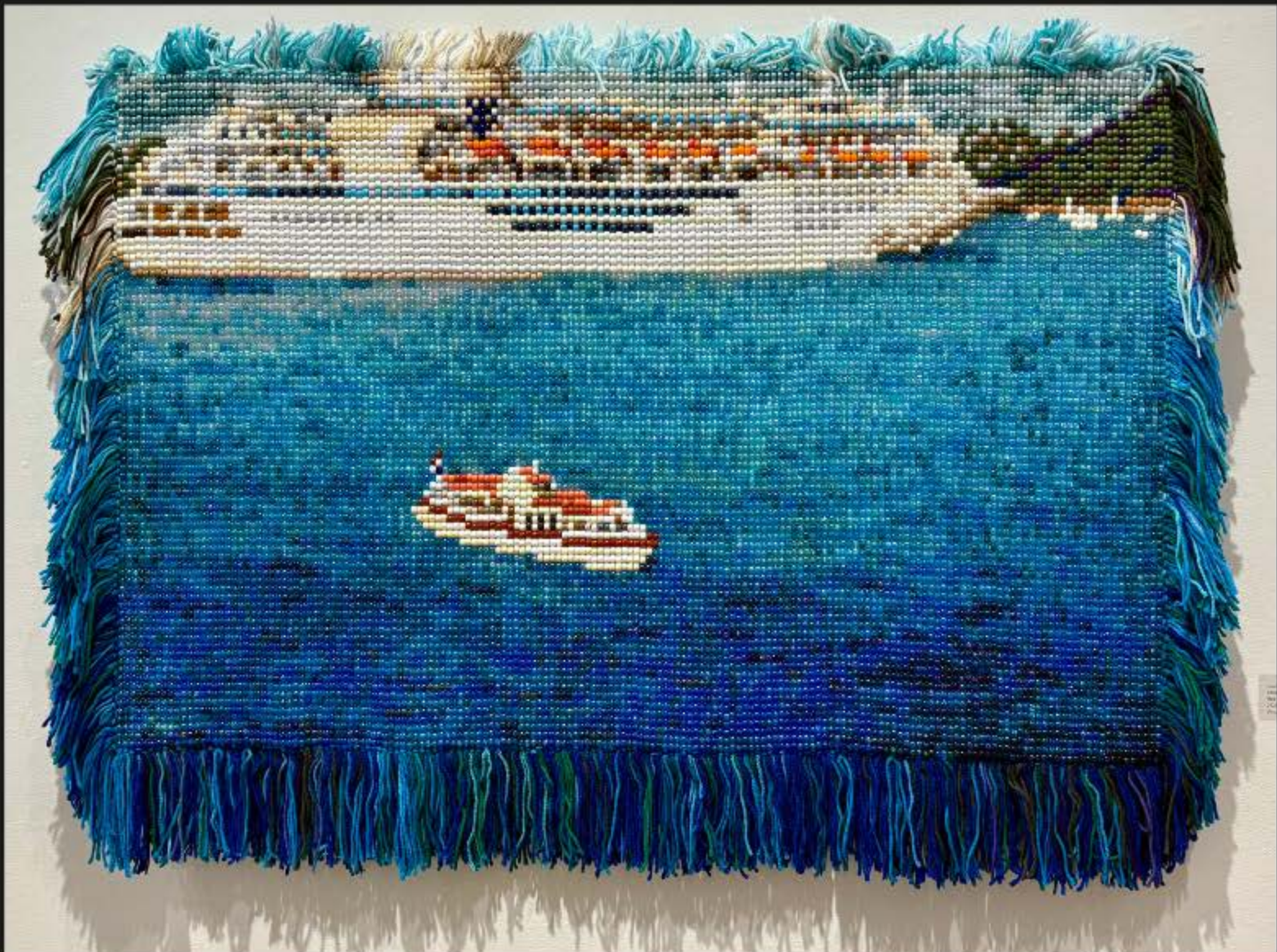

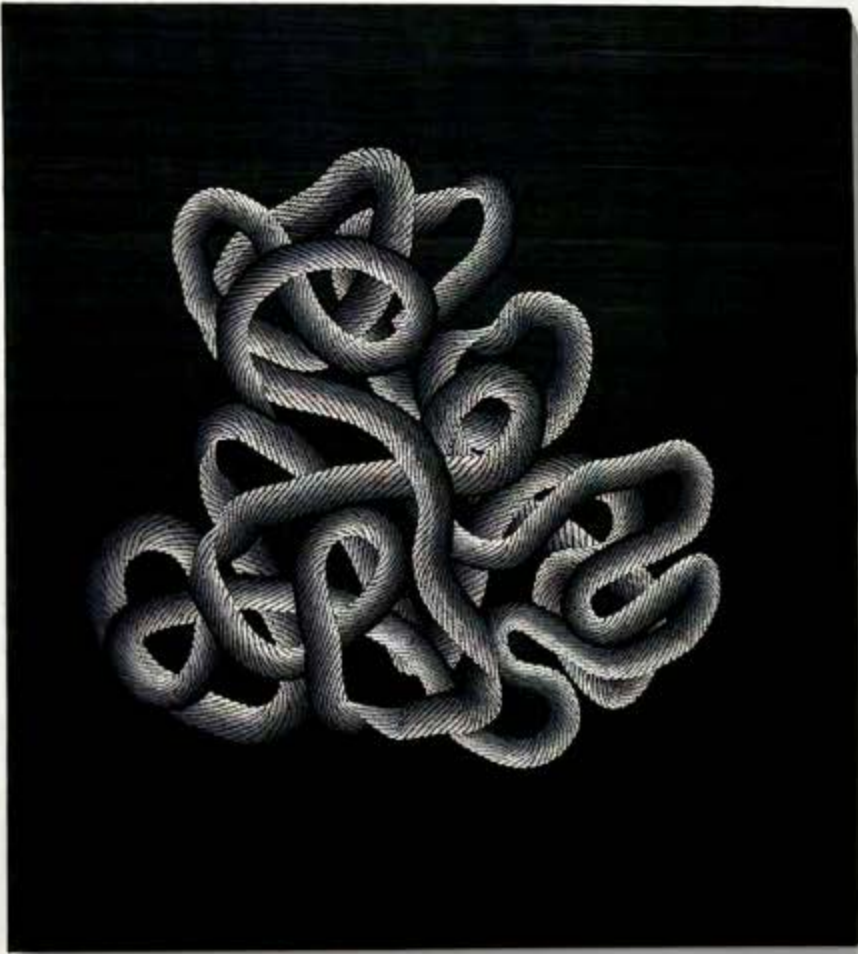
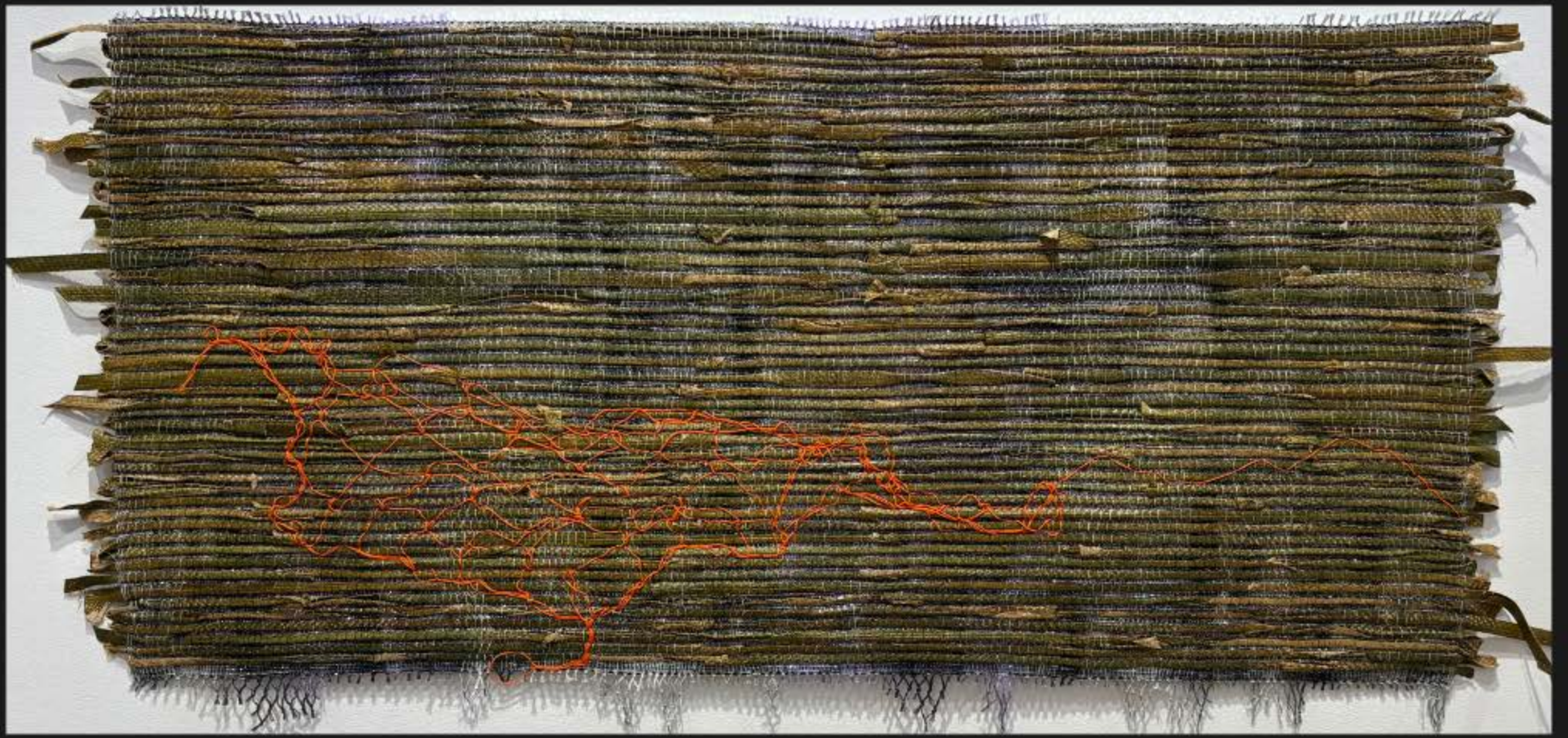




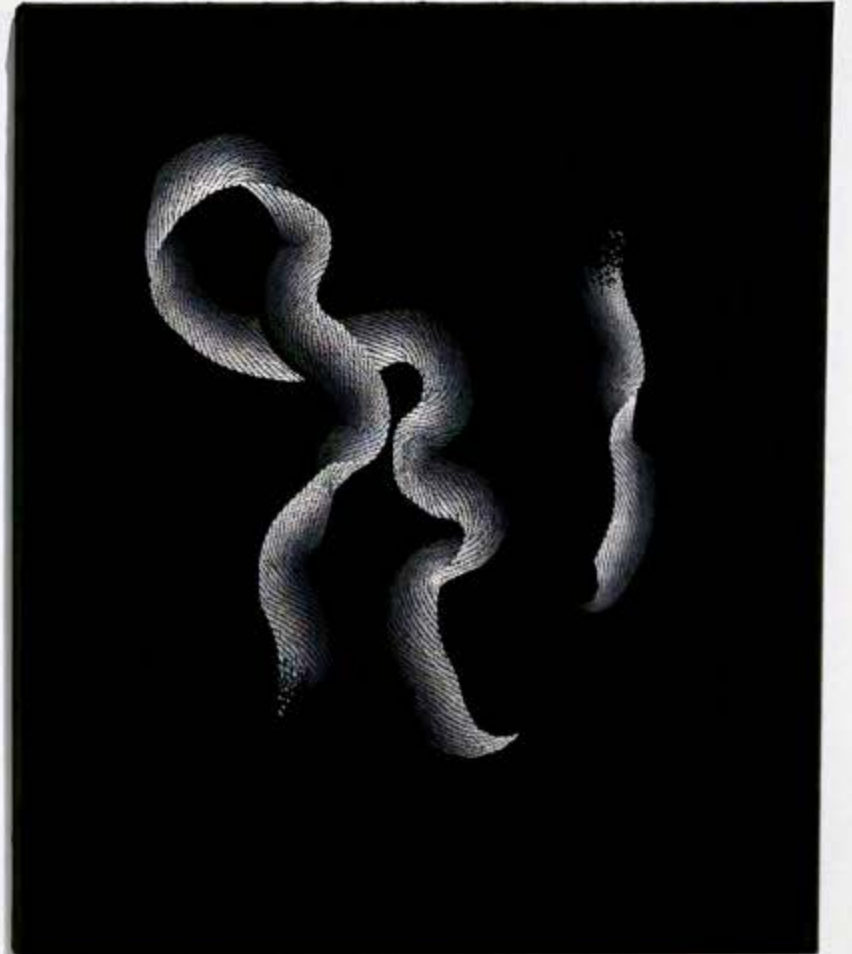








Knotted Rope

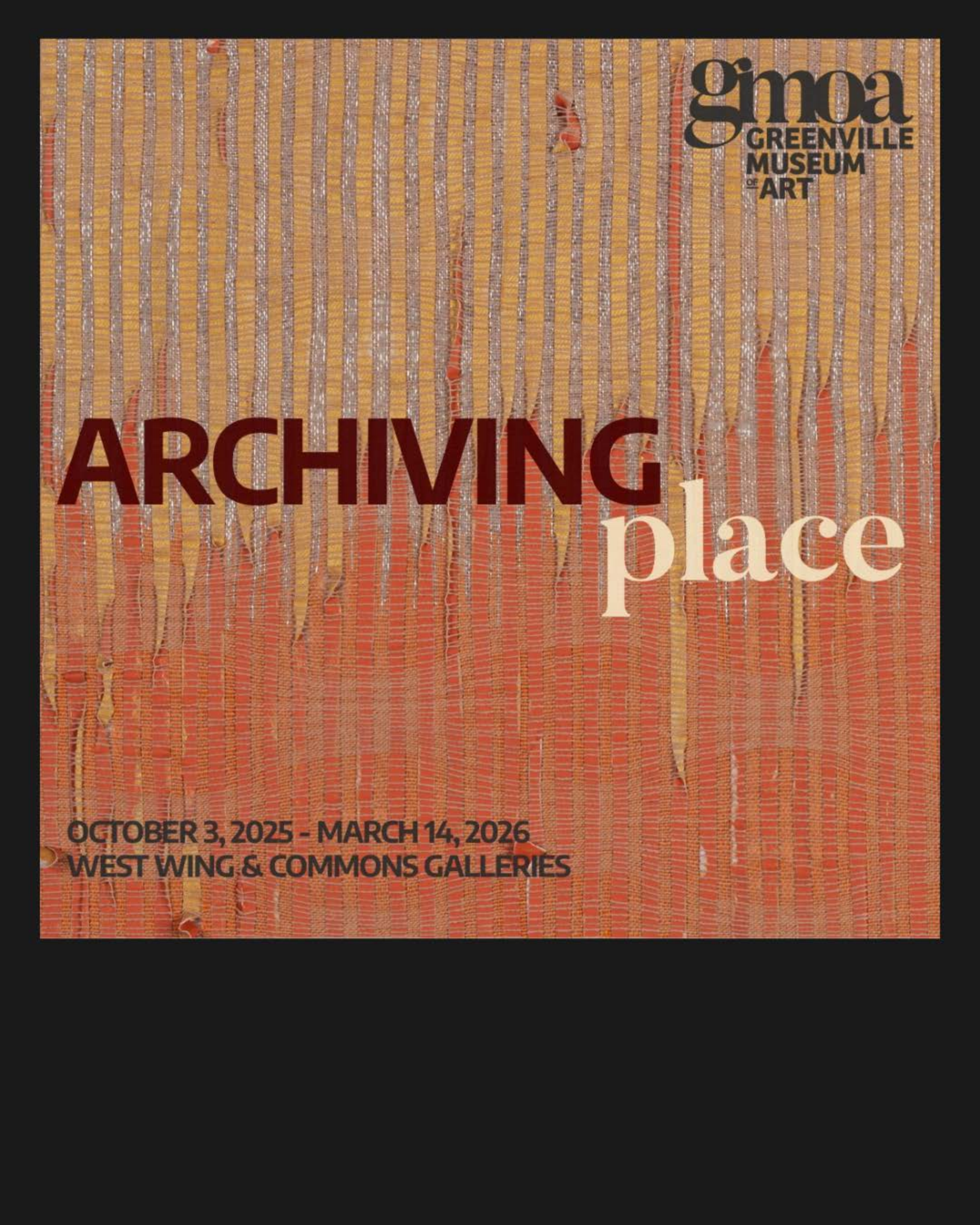
